Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an Order, Writ or direction more particularly in the nature of the Writ of Mandamus:-

- (a) Declaring the action of the Respondent No. 4 in issuing vacation notice dated 07/11/2025 vide Notice. No. 533/TPS/24/C6/CRZ/GHMC/2025, Dt- 07-11-2025, by directing the Petitioners herein to remove deviated portion within 72 hours without considering the Judgment Dt- 18-03-2025 in OS No. 592 of 2022 on the file of Honble VII Senior Civil Judge, City Civil Court, At- Hyderabad, as being bad, arbitrary, high-handed, illegal, unconstitutional, violative of Article 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India consequently DIRECT the Respondent Nos.4

not to take any corrosive steps against the Premises bearing number 16-1-553 (Old) 16-1-553/2/1, admeasuring 200 Sq Yards, situated at Saidabad, Hyderabad. That apart, the said action is also challenged as contrary to the principles of Natural Justice.

- (b) Consequently, set-aside the speaking order passed by the Respondent No.4 vide Notice. No. 533/ TPS/ 24/C6/CRZ/GHMC/ 2025, Dt- 07-11-2025 and
- (c) Consequently, direct the Respondents herein not to take any corrosive steps against the Premises bearing number 16-1-553 (Old) 16-1-553/2/1, admeasuring 200 Sq Yards, situated at Saidabad, Hyderabad.

RAPARTHI VENKATESH Advocate for the Respondent Nos.2 to 5, the Court made the following.
