Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to permit the petitioner/respondents No 1 to 4 to withdraw the amount of Rs 19,49,321/- deposited by the respondent No 1/appellant herein pursuant to order dated 20/11/2025 passed in IA No 3 of 2025 in MACMA No 1654 of 2025, pending disposal of MACMA No. 1654 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

IA No 3 of 2025:

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings pursuant to the Order and decree dated 2-02-2025 passed in M.V.O.P. No. 464 of 2022, on the file of Motor Accidents claims Tribunal - cum - Principal District Judge, at Khammam, pending disposal of MACMA No. 1654 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court dated 20.11.2025 made in IA No 3 of 2025 and upon hearing the arguments of Sri BURUJU PAPA REDDY Advocate for the Respondent No.1 in IA No 1 of 2026 and Sri VISWANATHULA JAGAN MOHAN Advocate for the Petitioners in IA No 1 of 2026.

The Court made the following

ORDER

This Interlocutory application is filed seeking permission to permit the petitioners to withdraw the deposited amount by the 1st respondent in pursuant to the interim order dated 20.11.2025 passed in I.A.No.3 of 2025 in MACMA No.1654 of 2025.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that on account of death of the sole bread winner, the petitioners are in dire need of money for their sustenance and therefore, the petitioners may be permitted to withdraw the amount so deposited by the appellant-Insurance Company.

Having regard to the aforesaid submissions, this Court is satisfied that at this stage, permission can be granted.

Accordingly, the petitioners-claimants are permitted to withdraw the 50% of the decretal amount so deposited by the appellant-Insurance Company by following the procedure established by law.
