ORDER

***Per contra*, learned counsel for the respondent submits that the interim order dated 19.11.2025 had already stood vacated on 23.02.2026 due to non-compliance with the conditional order of this Court dated 19.11.2025.**

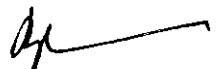
However, considering the submission regarding the ill health of the wife of petitioner No.1, this Court is inclined to grant a final opportunity to the petitioners by extending the time for payment of Rs.8,81,847/- (Rupees Eight Lakhs Eighty One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty Seven only) within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

It is made clear that in the event of non-compliance with this order, learned counsel for the respondent is at liberty to proceed with the execution proceedings.
