WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI. RAMESH CHILLA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order, or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the impugned File vide F.No. 61-1./2023(SA- III) Dt 04. 03. 2023 sent by the 2nd respondent through E- mail by which the petitioners candidature found not eligible to qualify for NFOBC, 2015- 17, for the reason that there were 9 candidates between the last candidate selected and the petitioner as illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory, and violative of principles of natural justice and Articles 14, 16, 19(g) and 21 of the Constitution of India, and consequently set aside the impugned File vide F. No. 61- 1/2023(5A- III) Dt 04. 03. 2023 and direct the respondents to award of Fellowship to the petitioner as he was entitled to Fellowship as per merit since no other candidate of 9 were eligible for fellowship,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri RAMESH CHILLA Advocate for the

Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
