Admittedly, the petitioner has not preferred any revision before the Joint Collector. She would further submit that, it is not the case of the petitioner that whether the appeal was dismissed or not but the fact remains on what strength the names of Kamishetti Murali, Kamishetti Ganesh and others were recorded in the enjoyers column and they have issued pattadar pass books and the said fact is not explained either in the impugned Memo or in the counter filed by respondent No.3. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue seeks time to obtain instructions on the said aspect. List on 20.07.2026.
