Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ or Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents 4 and 5 interfering with the Cafe Business of the Petitioner running under the name and style as M/s. Brew Cafe and Sports, Plot no 11, 13 and 14, Quli Qutub Shah Colony, Puppalguda, Gandipet Mandal, R.R.District, as illegal, arbitrary and violative of principles of the natural justice, unconstitutional;

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent No. More particularly the Respondent No. 4 and 5 not to interfere in any manner with Cafe and Sports Business runing under the name and style as " Brew Cafe and Sport". plot No. 11,13 and 14 Quli Qutub Shah Colony, Puppalguda, Gandipet Mandal R.R.District, pending disposal of WP 37030 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI M V V BASWA RAJ Advocate for the Petitioner and GP FOR HOME for the Respondents, the Court made the following.

ORDER

Learned counsel for the petitioner is submitted that on 20.12.2024, respondent No.5 - Station House Officer, Narsingi Police Station, along with his staff raided the Café of the petitioner under the name and style of M/s. Brew Café and Sports, on the allegation that they received information about the petitioner serving Hookah to his customers at his Café. The police found the information wrong and left the place. Despite the same, on the allegation that the petitioner is serving Hookah to his customers, there is interference by respondent Nos.4 and 5 in the business activity of the petitioner during peak hours.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home seeks time to get instructions.

There shall be interim direction to respondent Nos.4 and 5 not to interfere in business activity of the petitioner run under the name and style of M/s. Brew Café and Sports situated at Plot No.11, 13 and 14 of Quli Qutub Shah Colony, Puppalguda, Gandipet Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, without following due process of law.
