WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Sri Lalith Jogi presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to an appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly a Writ of Mandamus, to set aside the tender award and start the evaluation afresh strictly in compliance of the eligibility criteria and also declaring the action of Respondent Nos.1 and 2 in considering the bids of Respondent Nos. 3 and 4 without proper scrutiny of mandatory eligibility conditions as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Article 14 of the Constitution, and consequently direct Respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to conduct the eligibility evaluation strictly in accordance with the tender notification dated 20-

08-2025 and Corrigendum, and to declare Respondent Nos. 3 and 4 as ineligible and disqualify from participation and may begin afresh.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri LALITH JOGI Advocate for the Petitioner and Government Pleader for Telangana Technology Services Ltd., for respondent Nos 1 & 2 directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

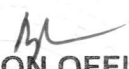
Learned Government Pleader for Information and Technology submitted that the contract is not yet been awarded and it is in process.
