ORDER:

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.

Post on 06.07.2026.

The presence of the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 9 in SC. Spl. No.117 of 2023 on the file of the Special Sessions Judge for trial of SC/ST (POA) Act cases-cum-Additional Sessions Judge Court at Nalgonda, is dispensed with, subject to the condition that they shall be represented through their counsel on each and every date of hearing. If the presence of the petitioners is required, they shall appear before the trial Court. In case of non-appearance on the specific date fixed by the trial Court for their appearance, the trial Court is entitled to proceed with the matter, in accordance with law.
