Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to declare the action of 2nd Respondent-The District Registrar of Societies, Ranga Reddy District, is issuing Endt.No. 6572/Society/2025, dated 22-9-2025 after the lapse of more than 3 months from the date of approval of the amendment of Nazarene Grammar School No. 8572 of 2000, dated 13-6-2025 as is being arbitrary, illegal, ultra virus, violative of Indian Registration Act 1908 and consequently set aside the same, further declare the inaction of Respondent No.1 Commissioner & Inspector General, Stamps Registration Department, T.S on the grievance ventilated

by the Petitioner through representation dated 6-11-2025 against the ultra virus action of Respondent No.2-District Registrar, Ranga Reddy District in circumventing the approved amendment dated 13-6-2025 of Society Registration No. 6572 of 2000 — Nazarene Grammar School, by issuing ultra virus endorsement dated 22-9-2025 to return the approved amendment dated 13-6-2025 is contrary to Indian Registration Act 1908, illegal, arbitrary, violative of Article 14, 21 of Indian Constitution and direct the Respondent No.1 to take action on the representation dated 6-11-2025 received from the Petitioner strictly in accordance with Indian Registration Act 1908 or any other law time being in force, as was ordered by this Hon'ble Court under similar circumstances in W.P.No. 10587 of 2025, dated 1-5-2025 between the Petitioner and Respondent No.1 and another therein, in the interest of Article 14, 21 of Constitution of India and pass such order or any other order this Hon'ble court deems fit in the interest of justice.

**Heard Sri B.Saramma, learned counsel appearing
on behalf of the petitioner and learned Assistant
Government Pleader for Stamps and Registration
appearing on behalf of the respondents.**

**2. The petitioner approached the Court seeking
prayer as under:**



"...to declare the action of 2nd Respondent- The District Registrar of Societies, Ranga Reddy District, is issuing Endt.No. 6572/Society/2025, dated 22-9-2025 after the lapse of more than 3 months from the date of approval of the amendment of Nazarene Grammar School No. 8572 of 2000, dated 13-6-2025 as is being arbitrary, illegal, ultra virus, violative of Indian Registration Act 1908 and consequently set aside the same, further declare the inaction of Respondent No.1 Commissioner and Inspector General, Stamps Registration Department, T.S on the grievance ventilated by the Petitioner through representation dated 6-11-2025 against the ultra virus action of Respondent No.2-District Registrar, Ranga Reddy District in circumventing the approved amendment dated 13-6-2025 of Society Registration No. 6572 of 2000 - Nazarene Grammar School, by issuing ultra virus endorsement dated 22-9-2025 to return the approved amendment dated 13-6-2025 is contrary to Indian Registration Act 1908, illegal, arbitrary, violative of Article 14, 21 of Indian Constitution and direct the Respondent No.1 to take action on the representation dated 6-11-2025 received from the Petitioner strictly in accordance with Indian Registration Act 1908 or any other law time being in force, as was ordered by this Honble Court under similar circumstances in W.P.No. 10587 of 2025, dated 1-5-2025 between the Petitioner and Respondent No.1 and another therein, in the interest of Article 14, 21 of Constitution of India and pass Prayer amended as per C.O.dt.30.12.2025 in IA No.1/2025....."

3. The case of the petitioner in brief as per the averments made in the affidavit filed by the petitioner in support of the present Writ Petition is as under:-



The 2nd Respondent, District Registrar, Ranga Reddy District, had approved amendment of Society Registration No. 6572 of 2000 (Nazarene Grammar School). The amendment was approved on 13.06.2025. The 2nd Respondent curiously issued an endorsement dated 22.09.2025 (followed by communication dated 06.10.2025) proposing to return the already approved amendment by invoking Circular Memo dated 01.10.2010, without referring to any statutory provision under the Telangana Societies Registration Act, 2001 or the Registration Act, 1908. Aggrieved thereby, the petitioner submitted a representation to the 1st Respondent on 07.11.2025 seeking action against the 2nd Respondent. As no action was taken and the earlier W.P. No. 33440 of 2025 had been withdrawn on 03.11.2025 with liberty to file a fresh petition. The present writ petition is filed challenging the endorsement dated 22.09.2025, the inaction of the 1st Respondent, seeking consequential reliefs.

PERUSED THE RECORD:-

DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSION:-



4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, mainly puts-forth the following submissions:-

- i) The petitioner had submitted a detailed representation, dated 07.11.2025 to the 1st respondent herein, bringing it to the notice of the 1st respondent about the gross dereliction of duty by the 2nd respondent i.e., the District Registrar, Ranga Reddy District in issuing an endorment on 22.09.2025 proposing to return the already approved amendment dated 13.06.2025 of Society Registration No.6572 of 2000 of Nazarene Grammer School, which is contrary to the statutory provisions.
- ii) Though the said representation of the petitioner had been acknowledged by the office of the 1st respondent, no action had been initiated on the said representation as on date.

Based on the aforesaid submissions, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not insisting for the prayer as sought for by the petitioner in the present writ petition, but however seeks a direction to the 1st respondent to



consider the grievance of the petitioner as put-forth in the present writ petition, and also vide the petitioner's representation dated 07.11.2025 addressed to the 1st respondent herein.

5. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Stamps and Registration appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that the writ petition could be disposed of directing the 1st respondent to consider the grievance of the petitioner as put-forth vide petitioner's representation, dated 07.11.2025 addressed to the 1st respondent within a reasonable period.

6. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not dispute the said submission made by the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Stamps and Registration appearing on behalf of the respondents.

7. TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION:

- a) The aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case,
- b) The submissions made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and learned



Assistant Government Pleader for Stamps and Registration appearing on behalf of the respondents.

c) The contents of the petitioner's representation, dated 07.11.2025 addressed to the 1st respondent,

d) The discussion and conclusion as arrived at paragraph Nos. 4 to 6 of this order,

Without going into the merits of the case, upon consent of both the learned counsel on record, the writ petition is disposed of directing the 1st respondent to consider the grievance of the petitioner as put-forth vide petitioner's representation, dated 07.11.2025 addressed to the 1st respondent pertaining to the endorsement issued by the 2nd respondent, dated 22.09.2025 and pass appropriate orders within a period of four (04) weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order, in accordance to law, in conformity with principles of natural justice, by providing an oppournity of personal hearing to the petitioner and duly communicate the decision on petitioner's



representation, dated 07.11.2025 to the petitioner.

However, there shall be no order as to costs.

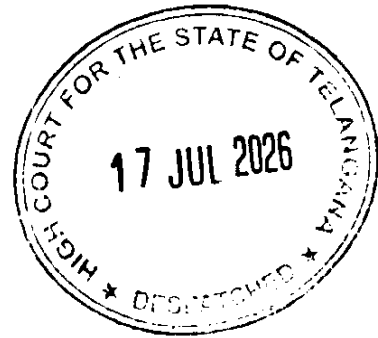
