Sri T.Niranjan Reddy, learned Senior Counsel representing Sri P.Vinayaka Krishna Vardhan, learned counsel for the petitioners, submits that the petitioners have not committed any crime and they have been falsely implicated in the present case. Further, the petitioners and LWs.1 to 7 were already settled the issue. Hence, the continuation of the proceedings against the petitioners is clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the above said submissions, this Court is of the considered view that detailed examination is required.
