The HDFC Life has to transfer an amount of Rs.32,18,114.94 to the account of the Drawing Disbursement Officer for which the No Objection and the consent letter of the petitioner has already been made available to the HDFC Life. The next step to be taken at the level of respondent No.6 is to certify the amount which the petitioner has to refund to the respondents so far as the petitioner's share is concerned which she has received past time which is already calculated by the	Transferred to i/o folder, before corrections, if any.



	petitioner and have been put in a tabular form with the Registrar General, High Court for the State of Telangana, who in turn has forwarded it to the respondent authorities way back on 25.11.2025. Now it is only the certification of the said amounts reflected in the said table which is to be carried out by the respondent No.6 which would help the petitioners also in making the refund so far as the petitioner share is concerned promptly. Only for this small step to be taken at the level of respondent No.6 and at the level of office of HDFC Life, the writ petition is getting prolong. Learned Government Pleader for Services – II submits that she shall pass an appropriate message to respondent No.6 in ensuring that the contribution which the petitioner has to make to the respondents is also either quantified or certified in a short period of time and she will also request respondent No.6 to pursue the amount to be retained from the office of HDFC Life, so that whole issue would get resolved with that. Let respondent No.6 therefore assist the learned Government Pleader for Services – II on the next date of hearing so that the present writ petition itself can be disposed of accordingly.
