Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order, or direction, more particularly, one in the nature of Mandamus.

a. declaring the action of the 3rd to 6th Respondents herein in not considering, and not acting upon the process of disbursal of pension to the Petitioner, as illegal, arbitrary, and violative of Articles 14, 16, 21, and 300A of the Constitution of India and,

b. directing the 3rd to 6th Respondents herein to process the pension papers of the Petitioner so as to facilitate the disbursal of such pensionary benefits to the Petitioner, as she is entitled to, including the arrears of unpaid pension and interest accrued thereon;

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 3rd to 6th Respondents to initiate the process for the sanction of pension to the Petitioner, as she is entitled to, pending disposal of WP 39063 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court dt. 19-12-2025, 22-01-2026 and 17-02-2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI B. MAYUR REDDY, Senior Counsel representing SRI PAIDA PRATIK REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner and SRI B. MUKHARJEE, Counsel representing SRI B. NARSIMHA SARMA, ASSGI for respondent No.1 and Ms. M. SHALINI, GP FOR SERVICES-II for respondent No.3 and SRI M. MURALI KRISHNA for respondent No.4, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Today the learned Government Pleader for Services – II has produced the correspondence dated 20.02.2026 issued by the Pay and Accounts Department, Government of Telangana, accepting the fact that the petitioner meanwhile has deposited her contribution to the State Government to the tune of Rs.9,23,950/- which includes principal + return and interest *vide* challan No.6504422796, dated 20.02.2026. The Pay and Accounts Department has further requested the Registrar General, High Court for the State of Telangana, to take appropriate steps in forwarding the requisite pension papers to the Pay and Accounts Department enabling them to scrutinize the same and release the pension to the petitioner at the earliest.

Learned counsel representing the Accountant General's Office further submits that once such a representation is made by the High Court to the Pay and Accounts Department, the Pay and Accounts Department, in turn, shall forward the same to the Accountant General and the Accountant General would thereafter issue pension payment order. ✓

In view of the aforesaid submissions made by the learned Government Pleader for Services – II and the learned counsel representing the Accountant General's Office, we post the matter on 09.03.2026 under the same caption. Meanwhile, the Registrar General, High Court for the State of Telangana, is expected to forward the requisite pension papers fixing the pension of the petitioner under the old pension scheme immediately to the Pay and Accounts Department for their necessary further steps for early releasing of the pension to the petitioner under the old pension scheme.

Meanwhile, the Pay and Accounts Department should also make all endeavours in getting the payment released from the HDFC Life to the State. Non-releasing of the funds from the HDFC Life should not come in the way of releasing of the petitioner's pension.
