WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate SRI P VAMSHEEDHAR REDDY presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the proceedings against the petitioner/Accused No. 2 in S.C.No.116 of 2024 On the file of the Special Judge for SCs STs Act Cases, Adilabad

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P VAMSHEEDHAR REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No. 2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 08.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of

grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings in S.C.No.116 of 2024 On the file of the Special Judge for SCs STs Act Cases, Adilabad against the Petitioner/Accused No.2, pending disposal of CRLP No. 16986 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

**The Court made the following:
ORDER:**

Mr.P.Vamsheedhar Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has not committed the alleged offences and has been falsely implicated in the present case only on the ground that she is mother of accused No.1. He further submitted that the petitioner never lived with respondent No.2 and accused No.1 and never harassed respondent No.2 for additional dowry. Hence, the ingredients of Sections 498(A) r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 and Section 3(1)(r)(s) of The Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 are not attracted against the petitioner.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that pursuant to the order dated 17.12.2025, the concerned Station House Officer informed respondent No.2 about filing of present criminal petition a week ago.

In spite of the said intimation, respondent No.2 has not chosen to enter appearance.

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Post on 08.03.2026.

Till then, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioner/accused No.2 in S.C.No.116 of 2024 on the file of the Special Judge for SCs/STs (POA) Act Cases, Adilabad.

In default of filing proof of service, the stay shall stand vacated.
