Sri T.Prathyumna Kumar Reddy, learned Senior Counsel representing

Mr. T.Anirudh Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the petitioner has not committed any offences and that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. Even according to the allegations made in the complaint, the ingredients of the offences under Sections 295 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, "IPC"), are not attracted against the petitioner. He further submits that the matter is at the summons stage before the trial Court and is posted to 20.01.2026.

Taking into consideration of the above said submission made by the learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner, this Court is of the considered view that the matter requires adjudication.

In view of the same, Notice before admission.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Post on 18.02.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioner/sole accused in C.C.No.9153 of 2022 on the file of the IX Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Ranga Reddy District at Kukatpally.
