WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Sri GOLAMARU VENKATA REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly a Writ of Mandamus, directing Respondent No.3 to forthwith vacate and hand over peaceful and vacant possession of the Petitioner's bearing Plot No. B-1/1, IDA Uppal, Medchal Malkajgiri District, measuring 1100 sq. yds., and an additional area of 366 sq. yds., totaling to 1466 Sq.Yards as the lease between Petitioner and Respondent No. 3 had expired as agreed and where Respondent No.3 continues to remain in unlawful, un-authorised and illegal occupation despite repeated requests and without any subsisting right and consequently to declare such continued possession as arbitrary, illegal and violates the Petitioner's constitutional rights under Articles 14 and 300-A of the Constitution of India.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri GOLAMARU VENKATA REDDY Advocate for the Petitioners, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.2 & 3 to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

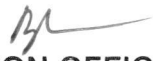
