AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. B. Venkat, learned counsel representing Ms. ROHITHA PRIYANKA BANALA Advocate for the Petitioner, PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 09.02.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 2 OF 2025

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings including the appearance of the Petitioner/Accused No.1 in C.C.No.1674 of 2025 on the file of the XIV Additional Metropolitan Magistrate at Prashanthangar, Kukatpally, Cyberabad, pending disposal of CRLP No. 17596 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER:

Mr. B. Venkat, learned counsel representing Ms. Rohitha Priyanka Banala, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the accused Nos.2 to 6 have approached this Court and filed Criminal Petition. This Court while ordering notice before admission, dispensed with the presence of the petitioners therein. He further submitted that the matter before the Trial Court is at summons stage. The petitioner herein is eking out his livelihood with difficulty. Unless this Court dispense with his presence, the petitioner would be put to great hardship.

Notice before Admission.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 through speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.

The presence of the petitioner/accused No.1 in C.C.No.1674 of 2025 on the file of XIV Additional Metropolitan Magistrate at Prashanthnagar, Kukatpally, Cyberabad, is dispensed with, subject to the condition that he shall be represented through his counsel on each and every date of hearing. If the presence of the petitioner is required, he shall appear before the trial Court. In case of non-appearance on the specific date fixed by the trial Court for his appearance, the trial Court is entitled to proceed with the matter, in accordance with law.
