WHEREAS the said case coming on for hearing, and whereas the High Court, upon perusing the affidavit filed therein, and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Deepak Misra, Advocate for the petitioners, made the following;

ORDER:

This Contempt case is filed complaining non-implementation of the order in WP.No.16003 of 2019, dated 19.12.2024 and also the order dated 24.07.2025 passed in Review IA.No.2 of 2025 in WP.No.16003 of 2019.

For the reasons stated in the accompanying affidavit, the Registry is directed to issue notice to the respondents to show cause as to why they should not be punished under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for non-compliance of the aforesaid order, by filing a counter-affidavit on or before 06.02.2026, failing which, they shall appear before this Court on that date at 10:30 A.M.

It is made clear that if the counter-affidavit is not filed on the date specified, the same shall not be accepted without payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to the Registrar (Judicial) by the respondents.

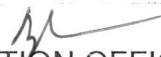
