JUDGMENT: (Per Hon'ble Justice Moushumi Bhattacharya)

1. The Commissioner of Survey Settlements and Land Records at Hyderabad, conducted a Survey of land in Sy.Nos.16, 17, 18/1, 18/2, 18/3, 18/4, 19 and 21 situated at Hydershakote Village, Rajendranagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, pursuant to the direction given by the learned Single Judge of this Court on 27.09.2018 in W.P. No. 27477 of 2014.

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2. The learned Single Judge order dated 27.09.2018 records that the Survey has already been carried out on 09.09.2014 and that learned counsel appearing for the appellants seeks to challenge the Survey Report before the Court.

3. The Respondent Nos.1 and 2 were Writ Petitioners in W.P. No. 27477 of 2014 who sought for setting aside of the order dated 09.09.2014 passed in Rc.No.F2/1762/2014 by the Commissioner of Survey Settlements and Land Records at Hyderabad.

4. The appellants were the respondents before the Writ Court. The dispute in the Writ Petition is brought before the Court that whether the Writ Petitioners' plots were situated in Sy. Nos. 15/1 or 18/4. The learned Single Judge allowed the Writ Petition No. 27477 of 2014 on 27.09.2014 setting aside the order dated 09.09.2014. Pursuant to the said order, a fresh Survey was conducted. The result of the fresh Survey aligned with the stands taken on behalf of the Writ Petitioners.

5. Learned counsel appearing for the appellants takes an objection to the findings in the Survey Report. However, the fresh Survey Report is not a subject matter in the present appeal. The Appellants are given liberty to challenge the Survey Report before the appropriate forum for conducting fresh survey in accordance with law.

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6. W.A. No. 1611 of 2018, along with all the connected applications, stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

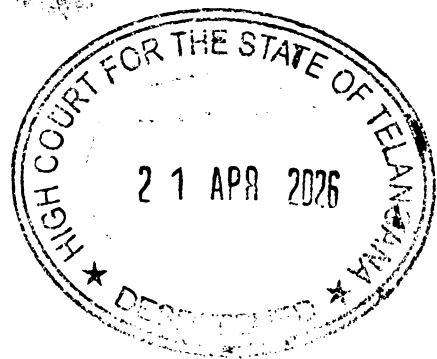
