1. Heard Mr. Jalan, learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioner.

2. It is the submission of learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioner that the Respondent (Judgment Debtor) - Mansi Shah has not complied with the order dated 17th July 2025 by which the Respondent (Judgment Debtor) - Mansi Shah has been directed to file affidavit of disclosure of her assets. Learned Counsel points out that although the time was taken for filing affidavit of disclosure the same has not been filed.

3. Thus, factual aspects on record prima facie shows that



Respondent (Judgment Debtor) – Mansi Shah has committed contempt by violating the said order dated 17th July 2025.
