1. Heard Mr. Yashodeep Deshmukh, learned Counsel appearing for the Applicants/Respondents. Also heard Ms. Reena Salunkhe, learned AGP appearing for the Petitioners-State.
2. The Interim Application No. 2643 of 2026 has been filed with a prayer to vacate the ad-interim order dated 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2026 passed in the Writ Petition. The primary contention of the Applicants is that the interim order has been obtained by jumping the Caveat lodged by his clients, i.e., the Respondents in the Writ Petition and that the issue is squarely covered by the Judgment of a Division of this High Court in the Nagpur Bench, delivered on 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2025, in Writ Petition No. 14 of 2025 in *State of Maharashtra vs. Prakash Madhukarrao Deshmukh and Ors.* Therefore, the Writ Petition itself is not maintainable.
3. Ms. Reena Salunkhe, learned AGP appearing for the State has, however, prayed for two weeks' time to file reply to the Interim Application. The prayer stands allowed.
4. Reply, if any, in the Interim Application be filed on or before 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2026.
5. The matter be listed again on **23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2026.**
6. Ad-interim order, passed earlier, to continue till the next date.
