Mr. Teckchandani, learned counsel for the Applicant submits that though there is an allegation of Applicant selling cars and the Informant have been paid a sum of Rs. 30,80,000/- to the Applicant and the Applicant not returning the said amount . However, the fact is that the Informant is a business partner of the Applicant and there are various entries to show that the Applicant have been paid monies to the Informant.

2. As the informant has not been made as a party Respondent, the Applicant is directed to add the First Informant as

a party Respondent No. 2. Amendment to be carried out forthwith.

3. The copy of the amended A.B.A. be served by the Investigating Officer upon the newly added Respondent No. 2. So also, it is permitted to the Applicant to serve a copy of the amended A.B.A. to the newly added Respondent No. 2 by private notice through the Advocate and file affidavit of service before the next date of hearing.

4. The Applicant is directed to visit the concerned police station on 25th February, 2025 and 26th February, 2025 between 11.00 am to 1.00 pm.

3. Stand over to **5th March, 2025.**

5. In the meantime, no coercive steps be taken against the Applicant.
