1. Heard rival submissions for sometime in the first sitting on this Criminal Revision Application preferred by the applicant. The applicant was convicted by the J.M.F.C.Court, Kalyan for the offence punishable under Section 509 of IPC and was acquitted for the offence punishable under Section 506 of IPC. Said conviction was

challenged in Appeal before the Sessions Court, Kalyan being Criminal Appeal No.4 of 2003. Appellate Court vide order dated 25.2.2011 uphold the conviction. As such, the applicant has been sentenced to suffer SI for six months and fine of Rs.200/- by the initial order of J.M.F.C. Court, Kalyan and which has now been confirmed. During the trial, the Applicant was on bail. However, after the appeal was rejected, he surrendered and presently in custody.

2. Heard. Admit. Criminal Revision Application be taken up for hearing as per its turn.

3. The applicant be released on bail on the same bail granted during the trial, with fresh bond to be executed before the concerned Sessions Court on the condition that the applicant shall attend the local Police Station to his residence once in a month on every first Sunday of the month from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon, for a period of six months.
