1. Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioner.
2. It is submitted that, the impugned orders were passed without providing an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, and the property in respect of which the impugned order was made to operate, by issuance of corrigendum on 29th January, 2026, was not referred to in the proceedings filed before the Maintenance Tribunal.
3. An arguable question is raised. Issue notice to the respondents for final disposal, returnable on 20th April, 2026.
4. Smt. Chipade, the learned AGP waives notice for Respondent Nos. 1 to 3.

5. In addition to notice through Court, the petitioner is at liberty to serve respondent Nos. 4 to 6 by private service and file an Affidavit of Service.

6. In the meanwhile, there shall be an ad-interim relief to the effect that, the execution, operation and implementation of Clause (2) of the order passed by the Appellate Tribunal dated 06th February, 2026 as modified by the corrigendum dated 29th January, 2026, shall remain stayed till the next date.
