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1. Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioners
2. The documents filed along with Petition themselves show that Respondent-Authorities appeared to be proceeding in accordance with law for acquisition of lands belonging to the Petitioners for the purpose of construction of a road. The document at Exhibit-'C' dated 25/11/2025 is a notice/notification for inviting objections from persons whose lands are proposed to be acquired through negotiations and execution of sale documents. The document itself specifies the time of fifteen days to raise such objections.
3. Although the learned counsel for the Petitioners vehemently

submits that such objections have been raised but they have not been entertained by the concerned authorities, we do not find any written document supporting the said assertion.

4. Nonetheless, it is submitted that if the competent authority, in this case Respondent No. 3, Sub Divisional Officer, considers the objections raised by the Petitioners including the objection regarding the alignment of the proposed road, the Petitioner would be satisfied.

5. In view of the above, hearing of this petition is adjourned to 1st April 2026, High on Board.

6. In the meanwhile, learned AGP will take instructions in the matter.
