2. The allegation in this contempt petition is that respondents have failed to comply with the directions issued in the order dated 16th December, 2025 read with order dated 23rd December, 2025. As per the said orders, respondent No. 1 was required to dispose of the representation of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of such representation being submitted.

According to the petitioner, such representation was submitted with respondent No. 1 on 7th January, 2026 and it is alleged that till date respondent No. 1 has not considered and disposed of the representation. The petitioner has not even been called upon to make presentation with regard to the issues raised in the representation.

4. Issue notice to the respondents for ascertaining of facts, returnable on 2nd July, 2026 (HOB).
