1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.
2. The matter is listed at serial no.905. We have called out the matter at the request of learned counsel for the petitioner. We have given the priority to the matter as Nashik Municipal Corporation is threatening to demolish the boundary wall and some of the part of the building today. It is submitted that the said boundary wall and the part of the school building which the Corporation alleges to come in the way of the road is in fact constructed after obtaining due permission. Our attention is

invited to plan at page 59 to demonstrate that the existence of the road in question and that the premises which are subject to the demolition notice do not come within the way of the said road.

3. The petitioner is running an educational institution in the name and style of “Sahaj Blossom English Medium School”. It is further submission of learned counsel for the petitioner that no opportunity of hearing is given to the petitioner before issuing such demolition notice.

4. In such view of the matter, issue notice to the respondent, returnable on 09/06/2026. Till then, the respondent-Corporation to refrain from taking any coercive action of demolition pursuant to the final notice dated 25/03/2026 in respect of the boundary wall and part of the school building which is the subject matter of the notice. The Corporation to act on the authenticated copy of this order.

5. List the mater on 09/06/2026.
