1. The Petitioner was working as a temporary from 2009 till 2019. He claims to have been appointed as a probationer on the post of Assistant Teacher on 1st April, 2019. According to him, the probation period would be completed on 1st April, 2022. He was not issued with a confirmation order and was transferred by the Management to the aided establishment. He further claims that on 7th June, 2019, the Incharge Deputy Director Education, Pune Division has granted approval to the appointment of the Petitioner as a probationer.

2. The learned Additional G.P. submits that the approval is not being granted because there is no confirmation order of the Petitioner on record. So also, there is no proposal forwarded by the Management to the Authority, for seeking approval.

3. **Issue notice** to the Respondents, returnable on **17th June, 2026**. The learned Additional G.P. waives service of notice on behalf of Respondent Nos.1 and 2.

4. Let the affidavit in reply be filed, on or before 10th June, 2026.

5. All office objections, if any, to be removed on or before 28th April 2026, failing which, the Registry shall dismiss the Petition without reference to the Court, on 29th April, 2026.
