1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner.
2. It is the contention of learned counsel for the Petitioner that permission to excavate was to the extent of 900 brass. Two permissions were granted. One is dated 15<sup>th</sup> December 2020 and the other is dated 27<sup>th</sup> January 2021. Learned counsel submitted that in any case, the Petitioner has not excavated more than 950 brass which is a total

permissible quantity as per the permissions. It is the submission of learned counsel for the Petitioner that the Tahsildar has taken into consideration only one permission granted ignoring the other permission thereby coming to the conclusion that the Petitioner has excavated additional 94 brass unauthorizedly.

3. Learned AGP seeks time to take instructions.

4. **Till the next date, no coercive steps be taken against the Petitioner.** Affidavit-in-Reply, if any, be filed in the Office within three weeks.
