2. By this petition, the petitioner has prayed for reliefs in the context of auction sale conducted by the respondent – bank (secured creditor).
3. The respondent – bank has taken steps under the provisions of the the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (Securitisation Act). Any grievance with regard to the same has to be raised by recourse to statutory remedy under the provisions of the Securitisation Act, by approaching Debts Recovery Tribunal (DRT).
4. The learned counsel appearing for the respondent – bank informs this Court that the petitioner has already filed Securitisation Application No.83 of 2026 before the DRT-II, Mumbai, which is listed



tomorrow (24.04.2026) for dismissal, on account of the fact that the petitioner has not appeared before the DRT also in the said securitisation application.

5. In the light of the fact that the petitioner has already taken recourse of the statutory remedy, we are not inclined to entertain the present petition. In any case, the petitioner has not placed any material on record, to show an extraordinary case for entertaining the present petition.

6. The writ petition is dismissed.
