Having heard learned counsel for the parties for grant of ad-interim /interim relief, we consider it appropriate that the Respondents file their affidavits in reply to the subject writ petition, considering the recent Delhi High Court judgment : **In Court on its own motion In RE: suicide committed by Sushant Rohilla, Law Student of I.P university.**
2. Mr. Godbole, on instructions, states that the re-examinations are scheduled to be held by the Respondent No. 5 – College in June 2026.
3. We are not inclined to grant ad-interim relief at this stage permitting the Petitioner to appear in the semester – VI examination for BBA

commencing from 8 April 2026.

4. Accordingly, Respondent Nos. 4 to 6 shall file their affidavit in reply to the writ petition on or before 21 April 2026.

5. The Petitioner is at liberty to file a rejoinder within a period of one week thereafter i.e. on or before 28 April 2026.
