1) The petition challenges order dated 17 March 2026 passed by the Competent Authority in the execution proceedings.

2) It is seen that the order of eviction has attained finality. The eviction order passed by the Competent Authority on 4 January 2024 was confirmed in Revision vide order dated 16 July 2024. This Court rejected



Writ Petition No. 12963 of 202 vide order dated 18 September 2024 which was filed by the Petitioner challenging the orders of the Competent Authority and Revisional Authority. The eviction order has thus attained finality. Now execution proceedings are sought to be questioned by raising new points. Since the order of eviction has attained finality, the Competent Authority is bound to execute the same. No infirmity is noticed in the impugned order. The Writ Petition is accordingly **rejected**.

3) With disposal of the Writ Petition, the Interim Application does not survive. The same also stands disposed of.
