

2. We are informed that the hearing on the application is part-heard and in an order dated 15.04.2026, the DRAT has recorded that the parties would jointly approach this Court for extension of time for deciding the said interim application.

3. The learned counsel for the applicants informs this Court that the Chairperson of the DRAT indicated that he may not be available for some period in the near future and therefore, extension of time may be sought, keeping that in mind.

4. In that light, the learned counsel for the parties jointly request for extension of time by eight weeks for deciding the interim application.

5. In view of the above, the application is disposed of by granting extension of time by eight weeks to the DRAT, for deciding Interim Application No.165 of 2026 in Regular Appeal No.8 of 2026.
