2. By the present Application, the Applicant has sought for the following substantive relief in terms of prayer clause (a) :-

“A. Grant anticipatory bail to the Applicant in connection with C.R. No. 201 of 2025 registered with Nerul Police Station for offences punishable under Sections 8(c), 20(b) (ii), 21, 23, 27A and 29 of the NDPS Act, in the event of arrest, on such terms and conditions as this Hon'ble Court
