2. Considered the report dated 14 September 2016 submitted by
Deputy Registrar, Civil Writ Petition Department.

3. Considering the submissions made by learned Counsel for the
Applicants and as the present Civil Application is filed within time, I am
satisfied that the Applicant has made out case for allowing this Civil
application. Hence, Civil Application is allowed in terms of prayer clause-

(B), which thus reads :-

{A} “(B) By allowing the civil application, the Hon'ble Court be pleaded to bring the names of the Applicants (as mentioned in the title of civil application) as the heirs and legal representatives of the deceased Petitioner- the Late Shri Manohar Krishnaji Barve on records and proceedings of the Writ Petition No.4853 of 2002.”

{B} The Applicants to carry out an appropriate amendment in Writ Petition No.4853 of 2002 within three weeks from today, failing which the Civil Application shall stand dismissed without referring back to the Court.

{C} If the amendment is carried out within a stipulated time as above, the Applicants to serve the amended copy of the Writ Petition to the Respondents or their Advocate thereafter immediately.

{D} Civil Application disposed of accordingly.
