1. Learned counsel for the Applicant/Appellant submits that the Applicant/Appellant is convicted by the Trial Court by order dated 8th April 2026 passed in Special Case Child Prot No. 205 of 2016. However, the said sentence is suspended for a period of 30 days. He referred to the order dated 8th April 2026 (Page 9).

2. The learned Trial Court has suspended the sentence of imprisonment of the Applicant/Appellant for a period of 30 days. The Appellant seeks extension thereof. This Court finds it

appropriate to extend the same till the next date of hearing. Appropriate further orders shall be passed after hearing the learned APP and the Respondent No.2-Victim. Hence, the order:-

3. Issue notice to the Respondents. The learned APP waives notice on behalf of the Respondent-State. Notice of the Respondent No.2 is made returnable on **22nd June 2026**.

4. The learned APP to instruct the concerned Police Station to intimate the Respondent No.2 about the pendency of the present Appeal and the Interim Application therein.
