- 1) Issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 11th June, 2026.
- 2) Learned Addl.G.Ps and AGPs waives notice on behalf of Respondent No.1 – State in all Petitions.
- 3) Mr. Anbhule, learned Counsel waives notice on behalf of Respondent Nos.2 and 3 – Pune University in all Petitions.
- 4) Mr. Warunjikar placed on record the communication dated 30/05/2026. It is taken on record and marked as 'X'. He prays for interim relief.
- 5) Heard learned Counsel for the respective parties.
- 6) The Petitioners have been pursuing 3 years, 4 years and 5 years programmes provided for different subjects. Presently, the Petitioners are in the final years of the programme they have been pursuing. The said programme is subject to N+2+1 scheme. However, the Petitioners could not

clear all the examinations of the said programme during the academic years commencing from the academic year in which they were admitted in the 1st year of the said programme. As a result, the Permanent Registration Number (PRN) of the Petitioners has been blocked by Respondent No.2 – University. Consequently, the Petitioners could not appear for the final examination of the said programme. Mr. Warunjikar, learned Counsel for the Petitioners submitted that, in the current academic session, all the Petitioners are in the final year programme of the subject they have been respectively been pursuing. Mr. Anbhule, the learned Counsel for the Respondent Nos.2 and 3 submitted that as per the recent communication dated 30/05/2026, those students who presently have been admitted in the final year as per the N+2+1 scheme and having a chance to get the degree by completing that year, a procedure is going on to fill in online examination application of such students. Those students are required to immediately fill in the application form and get it inward through the college concerned by paying the charges. The examinations for such students will be taken from 16th June, 2026. Soon, the detailed time-table will be published. Mr. Warunjikar and Mr. Anbhule stated that the case of the Petitioners is covered by the said communication dated 30/05/2026. Mr. Warunjikar submitted that the case of the present Petitioners is supported with the order dated 17/04/2026 passed in WP/3208/2026 by this Court.

7) In view thereof, the Respondents are directed to validate the PRN registered in the name of the Petitioners at the earliest and to allow

them to fill in and appear for the final year examination forms of the programme they are presently pursuing, subject to the further orders and final outcome of the present Petitions and without creating any equities in favour of the Petitioners.

- 8) The Respondents, if they so desire, shall file an affidavit in reply to the present writ petitions within a period of three weeks from today.
- 9) The Petitioners are at liberty to file an affidavit in rejoinder, if they so desire.
- 10) Place the Writ Petitions on 11th June, 2026.
