1. Heard learned Counsel for the Applicant.
2. The Applicant is apprehending arrest in C.R. No. 307/2026 registered by Bhiwandi Taluka Police Station, Thane Rural, Dist. Thane under Section 108 and 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (BNS).
3. The Applicants have filed instant application under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS).
4. Learned Counsel for Applicants points out that the Applicants are ladies. Applicant No.2 is a senior citizen. The allegations against them are about their involvement in the acts of beating the deceased and making allegations against his wife

and therefore on account of humiliation, he has committed suicide.

5. On perusal of the record and after considering the contentions of the Applicants, at this stage, the personal liberty of the Applicants need to be protected by granting ad interim protection.

6. In view of this, I pass the following order.

**ORDER**

- (i) Issue notice to the Respondent returnable on **25<sup>th</sup> June 2026.**
- (ii) Learned APP waives notice for sole Respondent.
- (iii) In the event of arrest of the Applicants in C.R. No. 307/2026 registered by Bhiwandi Taluka Police Station, Thane Rural, Dist. Thane, for the offence punishable under Section 108 and 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (**BNS**), the Applicant be released on furnishing P. R. Bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- each and solvent surety in the like amount.
- (iv) The Applicants shall attend the concerned Police Station on every Monday between 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and as and when called upon by the Investigating Officer.

- (v) The Applicants shall co-operate the investigating agency during investigation and trial.
- (vi) The Applicants shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.
