1. Heard learned Counsel for the Applicant.
2. The Applicant – husband is apprehending arrest in C.R. No. 58 of 2026 registered by Nizampura Police Station, Thane City, Dist. Thane, for the offences punishable under Section 85, 91, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (BNS).
3. Learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that except this Applicant who is the husband, all other relatives of the Applicant who were roped in as accused persons are released on bail, by order dated 2nd April 2026 in Anticipatory Bail Application No. 778 of 2026.
4. He submits that the only reason putforth before the Sessions Court by the prosecution was about non cooperation of

the Applicant and in this regard on instructions, he makes the statement that the Applicant is ready to co-operate the investigating agency.

5. On perusal of the documents on record and after considering the contentions canvassed at this stage, the personal liberty of the Applicant needs to be protected by granting ad-interim protection.

6. In view of this, I pass the following order.

ORDER

- (i) Issue notice to the Respondents returnable on **30th June 2026**. Learned APP waives notice for Respondent No.1.
- (ii) In the event of arrest of the Applicant in C.R. No. 58 of 2026 registered by Nizampura Police Station, Thane City, Dist. Thane, for the offences punishable under Section 85, 91, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (**BNS**), he be released on furnishing P. R. Bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- and solvent surety in the like amount.
- (iii) The Applicant shall attend the concerned Police Station on every Monday and Friday between 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and as and when called upon by the Investigating Officer.

- (iv) The Applicant shall co-operate the investigating agency during investigation and trial.
- (v) The Applicant shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.
