1. Mr. Suresh Sabrad, learned counsel for the Petitioners seeks leave to amend the Petition to add National Spot Exchange Limited (NSEL) as a party Respondent/Respondent No. 3.
2. Leave to amend is granted. Amendment to be carried out forthwith.
3. Issue notice to the Respondents, returnable on 10th June 2026.
4. Mr. Tanvir Khan, learned APP waives notice on behalf of Respondent Nos. 1 and 2. He further states that Ms. Leena Patil, SPP is appearing for Respondent Nos. 1 and 2 , but she is unable to attend due to personal difficulty.
5. Ms. Jalpa Shah, learned counsel appears for Respondent No.3 and waives notice.
6. Learned counsel for the Petitioners prayed for ad-interim relief. Hence, heard learned counsel for the parties.
7. Mr. Sabrad, the learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the Petitioners are the owner of the property to be auctioned on 1st June 2026. However, the Petitioners have no notice of the attachment

and auction proceedings of the said property.

8. Ms. Shah the learned counsel for Respondent No.3 tendered an order dated 8th May 2026 passed in Criminal Appeal No. 3371 of 2026 and other connected matters and pointed out that as per the said order, the Respondent/State is directed to appoint a new competent authority. The case in hand is covered by the said order dated 8th May 2026. Therefore, it is not clear whether the erstwhile competent authority or new competent authority will assist trial Court to proceed with the subject matter auction proceedings scheduled on 1st June 2026.

9. Considering the aforesaid submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties, there shall be an ad-interim stay to the subject auction proceedings in terms of prayer clause (e) till the next date.
