1. During the course of the hearing, it came to light that certain subsequent developments have taken place and in that context relevant documents are required to be placed on record.

2. We are of the opinion that in all fairness the petitioners ought to have placed on record a copy of the Interim Application No. 170 of 2026 filed in pending Securitisation Application No.321 of 2024 for a proper and comprehensive consideration of the issues sought to be

raised in the present writ petition.

3. Respondent No.2, the secured creditor, is represented by counsel and he submits that the present Writ Petition is wholly misdirected and that the order passed by the Debts Recovery Tribunal, II, Mumbai in the aforementioned Interim Application No. 170 of 2026, correctly observes that the grievance sought to be raised on behalf of the petitioners is premature.

4. In order to properly deal with the rival contentions, it would be necessary for this Court to peruse all the relevant documents.

5. In this background, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks a short adjournment to file an additional affidavit in order to place on record all the relevant documents in the context of the observations made hereinabove.

6. Additional affidavit with documents be filed within one week from today.

7. List this petition for further consideration in the category of fresh matters on 1st July 2026.
