- 2) Mr. Kakade, learned Addl.GP, Mr. Anbhule and Mr. Rui Rodrigues, learned Counsel waive notice on behalf of Respondent Nos.1, 2 and 26, respectively.
- 3) Ms. Inamdar shall provide copies of the Interim Application to the Registry during the course of the day.
- 4) Ms. Inamdar, learned Counsel for the Applicants/Intervenors

prays for an interim relief. Hence, and considering the facts of the case, heard learned Counsel for the respective parties.

5) Ms. Inamdar, learned Counsel submitted that Applicant Nos.3 and 4 have cleared the backlog of the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of Bachelor of Architecture and Applicant Nos.1, 2 and 5 have cleared the backlog of the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of Bachelor of Architecture. Because of the backlog subjects, the Applicants have been provisionally admitted to 4<sup>th</sup> year and 5<sup>th</sup> year of Bachelor of Architecture as per the “carry on” system provided in Circular No.209 of 2025 issued by Respondent No.2. They have completed their respective 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year by securing the required credit. Therefore, in view of the Order dated 11<sup>th</sup> November 2025, in WP No.11651 of 2025, the Applicants/Intervenor are entitled to fill in the Application form and appear for the examinations of 4<sup>th</sup> year and 5<sup>th</sup> year of Bachelor of Architecture.

6) The aforesaid submissions made by Ms. Inamdar is supported with the Orders passed by this Court on 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2025 and 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2025 in Writ Petition No.11651/2025 as well as the Order dated 18<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 passed in IA/3640/2026, IA/3622/2026, IA/3624/2026, IA/3630/2026 and in IA/3641/2026.

7) In view thereof, by way of an interim measure, Savitribai Phule Pune University is directed to accept the application form of the Applicants/Intervenors for the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> semester examinations of the 4<sup>th</sup> year and 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> semester examinations of the 5<sup>th</sup> year of Bachelor of Architecture, as the case may be, scheduled on 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2026 and onwards and permit them to

appear for the said examination including practical examination/s, if any.

8) The rights and contention of the parties are explicitly kept open.

9) The appearance of the Applicants/Intervenors in the examination/s including the practical examination and the declaration of their results, shall remain subject to the Orders dated 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2025, 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2025, the final outcome of Writ Petition No.11651 of 2025 and the ultimate adjudication of the legality and applicability of the “Carry On” system.

10) The aforesaid permissions is subject to the Savitribai Phule Pune University being satisfied that the Applicants/Intervenors have cleared the backlog of the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year examinations as submitted by Ms. Inamdar.

11) The said University and/or the respective colleges shall verify the mark-sheets and the eligibility credentials of the Applicants/Intervenors forthwith/before the examination where it is possible and in due course, so as to ensure that only eligible students are able to appear for the examinations scheduled from 3<sup>rd</sup> June to 12<sup>th</sup> June 2026 and avail the benefit of this interim protection.

It is made clear that if part of the said examination is already over, then permitting the applicants to appear for re-examination or supplementary examination of the said part shall be subject to the rules and regulations applicable to such re-examination or supplementary examination.

- 12) The Applicants/Intervenors, on instructions, undertake not to claim any equities on the basis of this Order. It is made clear that the benefit of this Order is restricted to the present Interim Application.
- 13) Let the Interim Application be placed for further Orders on 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2026 alongwith Writ Petition No.11651 of 2025.
- 14) All concerned to act on an authenticated copy of this Order.
