. The petitioner in Writ Petition No.7156 of 2026 has also filed Interim Application No.3890 of 2026 in Writ Petition No.6456 of 2026. Although the said application is styled as an application seeking vacation of order dated 07.05.2026, the learned counsel appearing for the applicant submits that only a clarification is sought.
