1. A serious dispute in this matter is as regards the
address tendered by the father of the child, namely, Sandip Baburao
Sathe, which does not match with the address of the residence of
Mr. Sathe.

2. The learned Addl. GP for the State submits that much
efforts were made today. Mr. Sathe's cell phone number was taken
from the learned Advocate for the Petitioner and he was called. He
kept on assuring that he would reach his residence, but he did not

appear.

3. As a last chance, let Mr. Sandip Baburao Sathe remain present at 11.30 a.m. tomorrow, i.e., 20th June, 2026, at the residence address mentioned in the application form for seeking admission of the child Master Manas. He should be at the said place at 11.30 a.m. along with all such documents that would indicate his residence proof. He would also produce his latest cell phone bill of the month of May, 2026 along with the latest electricity bill and his Election Commission Voter ID card.

4. The learned Advocate for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner would obey these directions. The learned Addl. GP for the State submits that the officials would be present at 11.30 a.m. at the address which is shown as residential address of Master Manas in the application for admission to the school.

5. Stand over to **22nd June, 2026** in the '**Urgent Supplementary Board**' for disposal.
