ORDER :

1. The Learned Additional Government Pleader fairly submits that the enhancement in question falls very close to the parameter of four times the original compensation as awarded by the Learned Special Land Acquisition Officer, the value being Rs.1,56,926 in the first instance and the enhancement being Rs.7,11,556. The gap being just Rs. ~83,000, considering that the State can take a conscious decision not to expend energy and resources in pursuit of an Appeal where the enhancement is below four times, pursuant to the Government Resolutions dated November 3, 2016, May 11, 2018, and August 13, 2018, it is felt appropriate to permit withdrawal of this rather old appeal.



2. In these circumstances, the Learned Additional GP is permitted to withdraw this Appeal.
3. The Appeal is hereby *finally disposed of*.
4. Refund of Court fees in accordance with the rules.
5. Since the Appeal is being withdrawn, it is expected that there shall be compliance with the impugned order as expeditiously as possible, preferably within 8 weeks from the upload of this order on the website of this Court.
