1. The Applicant/Appellant seeks condonation of delay of one year and 84 days in preferring the First Appeal against the judgement and order dated 3rd March 2018 passed by the Bombay City Civil Court in Short Cause Suit No. 7306 of 2005.
2. Mr. Rohan Sonawane, learned Counsel for the Applicant/Appellant says that there is a typographical error in the

prayer clause regarding the period of delay, which ought to have been 157 days, but which has been re-written as one year and 84 days.
