1. We have a report from Mr Trivedi pursuant to our directions dated 9th and 28th February 2022. Mr Trivedi had before him 43 matters. The tabulation annexed or included in the report does not tally exactly with the board listing today. However, from the matters that were listed before Mr Trivedi, he has been able to identify those matters where there is interim relief, those where there is no interim relief, and also whether or not the case of the petitioner is that there is a procedural infirmity in the impugned orders. In all cases but one (Original Side Writ Petition No. 2545 of 2021) there is some procedural infirmity or the other alleged.

2. In Writ Petitions Nos. 8016 of 2019 and 11454 of 2019, to be heard with First Appeal (L) No. 23059 of 2021, there is a

substantive vires challenge placed by the Petitioners/Appellants. Mr Tally for the Petitioners/Appellants informs us that there is a challenge to the constitutionality and the power of the Chief General Manager to issue wilful defaulters circulars, directions or notifications.

3. We propose to consider these submissions at the forefront because the decision on the vires challenge may well affect the authority to issue circulars in all other matters.

4. Mr Arsiwala appears for the Petitioners in Sr. No. 46, Writ Petition (L) 3725 of 2022. His challenge is on a slightly different footing, namely that there is an entirely artificial creation of a sub-class guarantors who are sought to be treated as wilful defaulters irrespective of the conduct of the principal debtor. This will be the next challenge but limited to the sub-class of guarantors.

5. As regards all the other cases where there is a challenge to a procedural irregularity and infirmity, we propose to hear Mr Bookwala as the lead counsel on the correct interpretation of the relevant guidelines, circulars and notifications (subject of course to the result of the two vires challenges mentioned above). If we find that any Petition is contrary to the interpretation that we finally adopt, necessarily those Petitions will succeed and the wilful defaulters notifications or declarations will fail. If, however, we find that there are cases where there is sufficient or adequate compliance and no procedural infirmity, then the individual cases will have to be taken up one by one to see whether the declarations of wilful

defaulters were or were not justified in the facts of that particular case and subject to the limited examination possible in writ jurisdiction.

6. We have made this orders only so that all can proceed systematically through the entire group of 43 or more matters.

7. Mr Shah's case at Sr No. 24, Writ petition No. 2545 of 2021 stands perhaps on a entirely different footing. In this case, the Petitioners actually been removed from the list of wilful defaulters. There is, therefore, no challenge per se to any wilful defaulters notification. Indeed, the Petitioner has a no dues certificate. However, presumably on the basis that the Petitioner was — once upon a time — declared a wilful defaulter, he has been informed that his creditworthiness will remain negative for next five years and that he also cannot approach any bank for any facilities. This question is unaffected by any larger question of vires or of procedural infirmity. We propose to segregate Sr No. 24 and take it separately.

8. Sr No. 24, Writ Petition No. 2545 will be listed on 22nd March 2022.

9. As regards the remaining matters, we accept Mr Purohit's suggestion that a one-page note briefly highlighting the procedural challenges in each matters may be submitted to Mr Trivedi.

10. We request Mr Trivedi to rework his list so that it follows the listing on today's board to avoid any mix up.

11. Any Advocates who did not appear before Mr Trivedi are given one further opportunity to place the necessary material before him.
12. We list the entire group on 31st March 2022 at 2:30 pm.
13. If for any reason we are not able to dispose of any matter finally, we will consider the question of interim relief.
