1. Heard learned Counsel appearing for the parties.
2. Earlier this matter was listed before another learned Single Judge. By partial modification dated 18th July 2025 *inter alia* the matters wherein impugned Orders are passed by the Family Court are assigned to this Court.
3. On 21st July 2025 this matter was mentioned before this Court and in view of the urgency that has been mentioned, this Court has kept the matter on 24th July 2025. As on 24th July 2025 the matter was not

listed before the Court, again immediately the matter was mentioned and in view of the urgency that has been mentioned the same has been directed to be placed at 03:00 pm on 28th July 2025.

4. Accordingly, the matter is listed today. However, perusal of the record shows that on 10th June 2025 the matter was listed before a learned Single Judge, however, as none has appeared for the Petitioner the same was directed to be placed on 8th July 2025 i.e. after a period of about 1 month. On 8th July 2025, the matter was adjourned by consent to 28th July 2025 and thereafter, immediately on change of assignment, on 21st July 2025 the matter is mentioned for urgent circulation.

Thus, in the facts and circumstances, the circulation was obtained by without informing the Court that the matter was earlier listed on 10th June 2025 before another learned Single Judge and as none has appeared it was adjourned to 8th July 2025 and thereafter on 8th July 2025 the same was adjourned by consent to 28th July 2025.
