2. This is an application for condonation of delay of 672 days in filing the revision application against the judgment and order dated 30th June 2023 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Panvel in Criminal Appeal No. 26 of 2021.
3. I have heard the learned counsel for the applicant and the learned counsel for respondent No.2.
4. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the order impugned in revision application is an ex-parte order and no

summons or notice was served upon the petitioner in the appeal filed by respondent No.2. It is submitted that delay in filing the revision thus may be condoned.

5. On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondent No.2 submits that there is inordinate delay of 672 days in filing the revision and the same may not be condoned.
