The Registrar (Judicial-I) vide orders dated 30/04/2024 had granted two weeks time to the learned Advocates for the Petitioners/Petitioners to remove office objections. Despite specific directions, the office objections are not removed till date.

Having considered the provisions under Rule 3 of Chapter XVII of the Bombay High Court Appellate Side Rules, 1960, period of 14 days is prescribed for removal of office objections.

In the circumstances, registration of all these petitions deserves to be refused.

However, instead of passing adverse order outrightly, it would be just and proper to give one more opportunity subject to condition.

In turn, the learned Advocates and the Petitioners are directed to remove office objections within two weeks without fail. On failure, registration of the above numbered Writ Petitions would stand refused automatically without further reference to the Court of Registrar.
