1. Heard the learned Counsel for the parties.
2. Office report shows that the Petitioner has not supplied the spare copy of the Petition, hence notice could not be issued.
3. Mr. Srinivasan, the learned Counsel for the Petitioners, undertakes to furnish a spare copy of the Petition for issue of notice to Respondent No.1.
